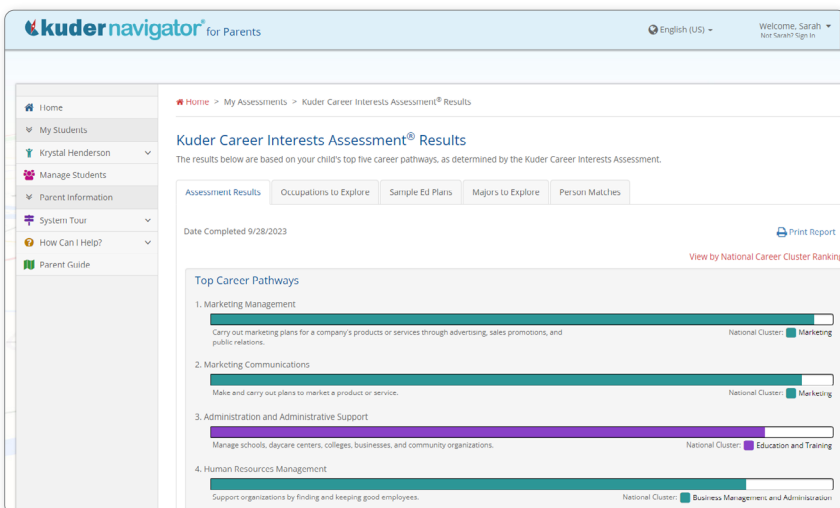
BEST PRACTICES
